



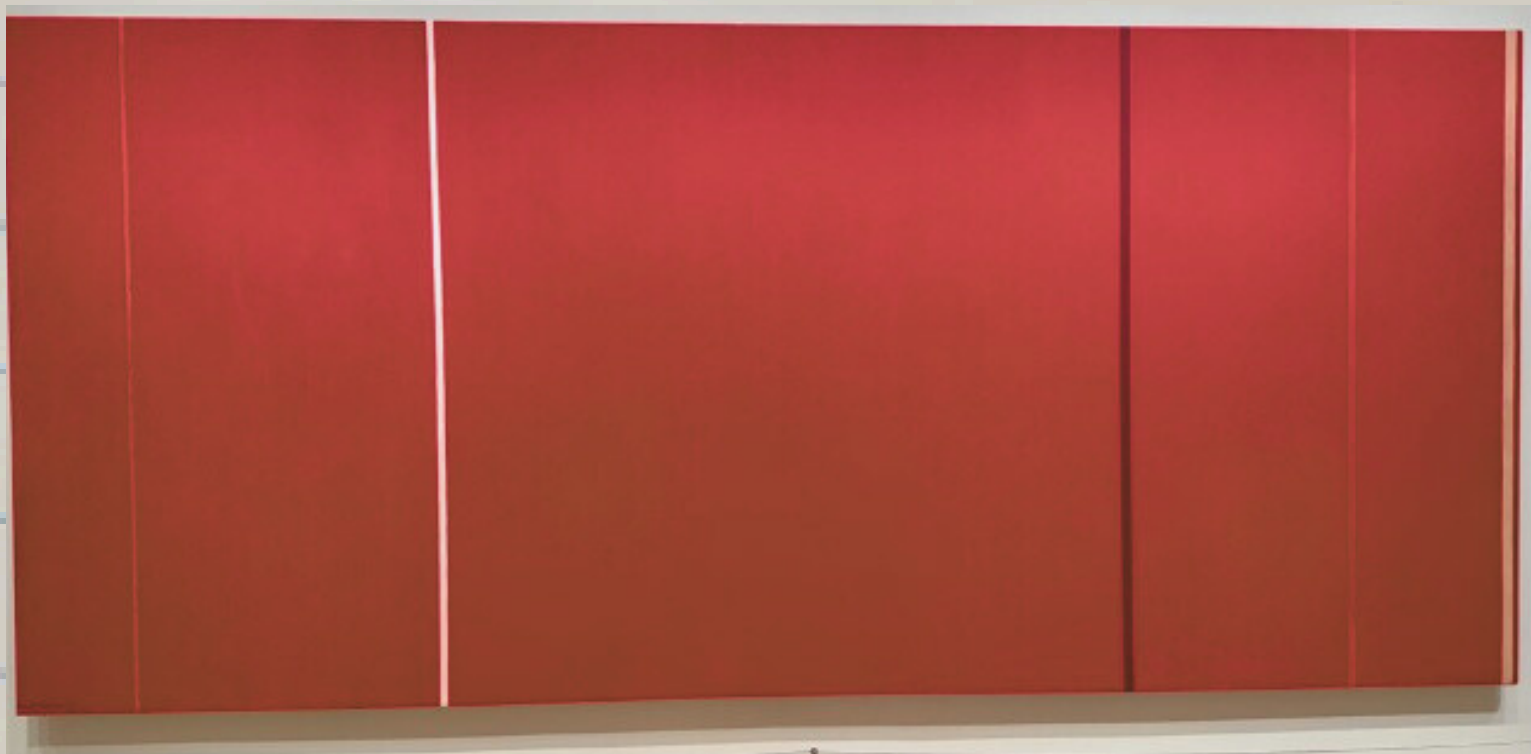
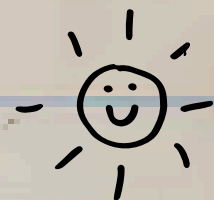

This piece is minimalist, yet expressive and bold

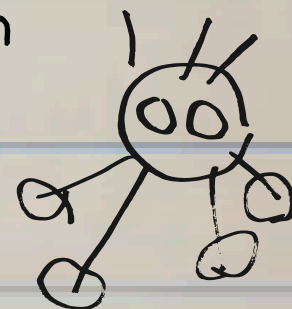
- Radiates a sense of power and introspection.
- The artist used the term "**Zips**" to describe the five thin vertical lines that break up the long field that embraces you when you stand close to it



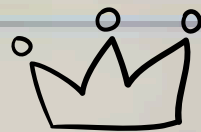

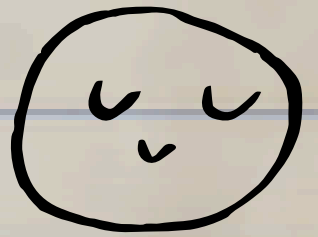

how do they connect?

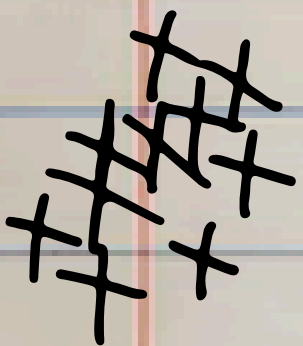
- use of bold deep reds to represent confidence and uniqueness



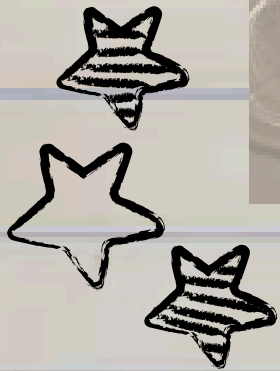
- similar colors are used in modern fashion to show courage (turns simple designs into eye-catching statements)

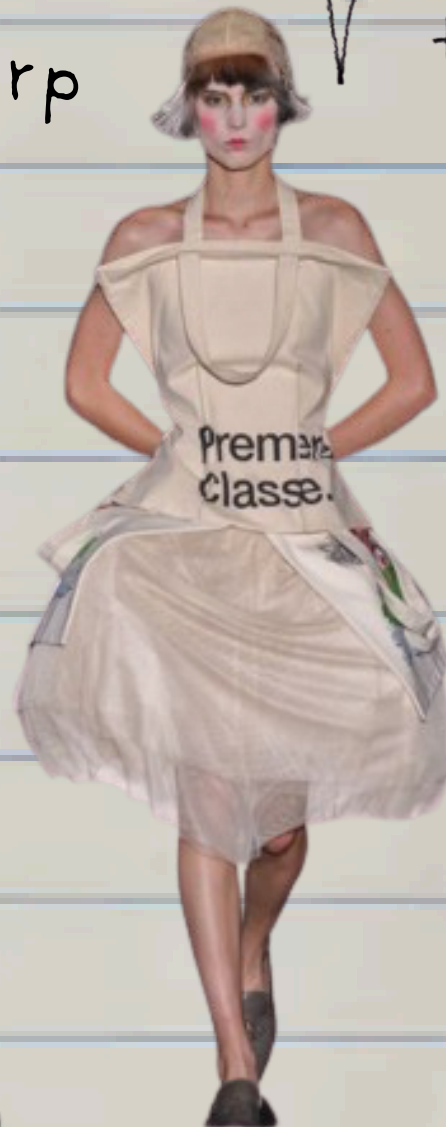
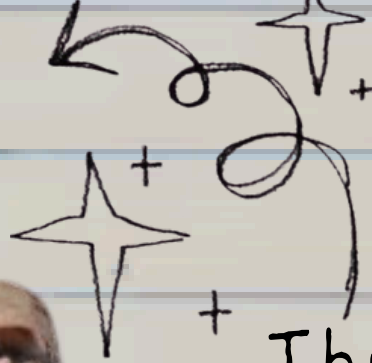
Focus on functional beauty and craftsmanship

how do they connect?



- Hoffmann's designs connect historical and modern trends through clean lines and geometric elegance
- similar to clothing like: column gowns, a-line skirts, and corseted garments
- long, tapering lines reflect a slender silhouette



- focuses on shape and structure

Wilke uses abstract forms and unconventional materials to address societal norms and celebrate individuality

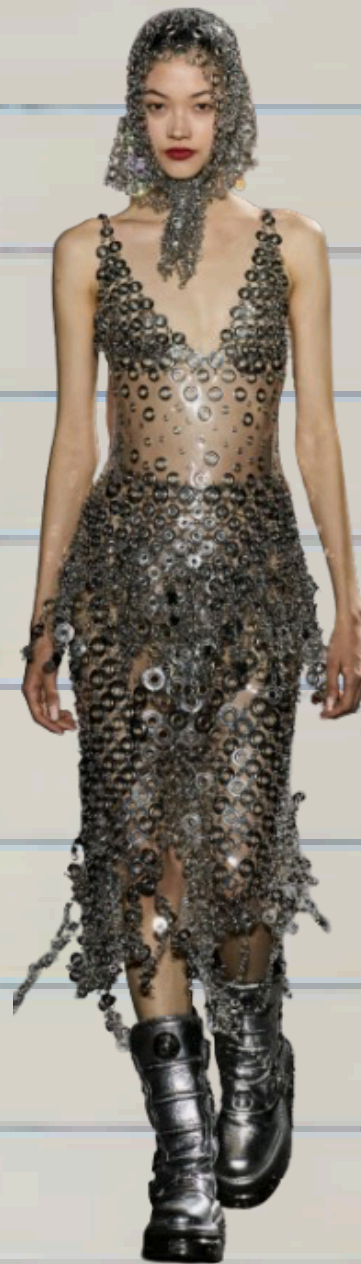
- latex, metal snaps, and push pins

- challenge taboos around female anatomy




Acne Studios' Paris show mixed its clean Scandinavian vibes with bold studded details on biker-inspired pieces, blending a dreamy feel with edgy urban style



At the Luisaviaroma show in Milan, silver accents added a sleek, futuristic vibe to the outfits, with studded metallic details that made the looks bold



In London, Richard Quinn used silver studs to highlight his bold silhouettes, framing floral designs and emphasizing exaggerated shapes, blending romantic and punk vibes for a dramatic edge



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
